To maintain public confidence and to prevent the use of public office for private gain, members of the Kawaikini Local School Board will disclose all potential conflicts of interest to the Board prior to the vote on any such transaction.

For purposes of this policy, situations which present a potential conflict of interest are those in which a Board member may derive a private benefit that is both pecuniary and personal in nature from Board action.

The disclosure will be included in the minutes of the meeting in which Board action occurred relating to the matter disclosed.

A board member who discloses a potential conflict of interest shall abstain from voting on the matter disclosed.
