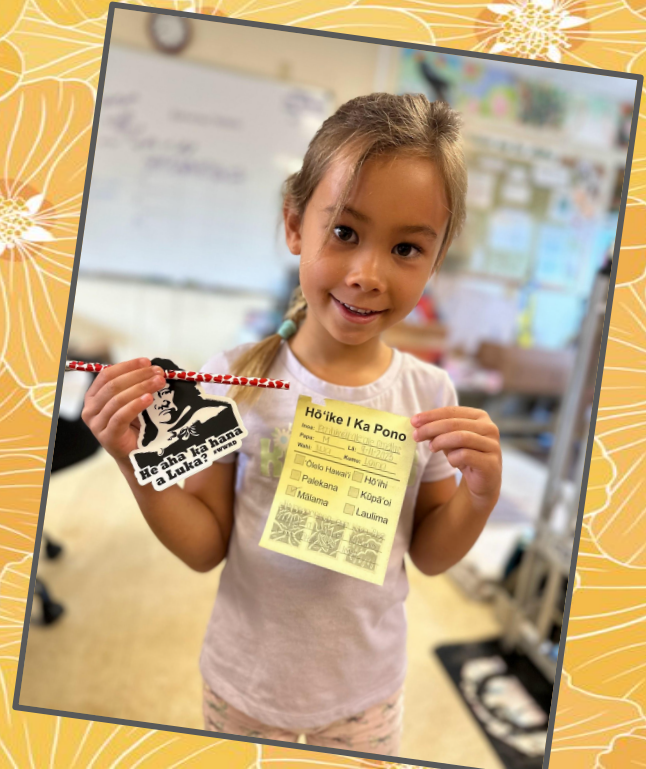
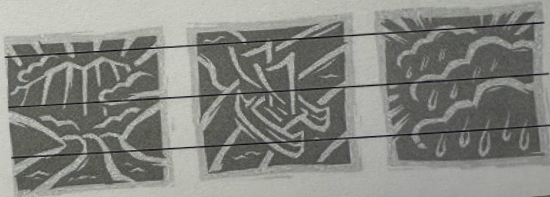

Kawaikini: Title I Part A SY23-24

Purpose of Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) - This program is to provide all children with a significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps. (ESEA section 1001)
