Re: SY 2020-2021 Quarter 3 Plan

Aloha kākou,

Mahalo nui for your cooperation, patience and support during Semester 1. We hope you and your family are safe and healthy. Since the beginning of quarter 2, there have been numerous meetings with different stakeholders, including several parent representatives to develop guidance to our school plans. Mahalo nui to all Guidance to Reopening subcommittee members!

Moving into quarter 3, we will be moving forward with a Hybrid learning model that will increase the number of students who have access to in-person instruction. A Hybrid Learning Model (Blended Rotation & Face-to-Face) means face-to-face learning with online instruction while students report to school twice a week on a blended schedule. Other identified students will be given more face-to-face instruction to the greatest extent possible (Hui Kōpiko). Off campus days will be different for specific grade level groups.

- For Grades Malaa'o to 2: Students will return to school 2 days per week on a blended rotation schedule. Instruction will be online and face to face during on campus days, and daily, online for off campus days.
- For Grades 3-6: Students will return to school 2 days per week on a blended schedule. Instruction will be face to face during on campus days, and continue at home with independent learning (homework/practice work) for off campus days.
- For Grades 7-12: Students will return to school 2 days per week on a blended schedule. Instruction will be face to face during on campus days, and daily, online for off campus days.

'Ohana opting for full distance learning:

- For Grades Malaa'o to 2: Students are at home with adult supervision and receiving instruction daily via virtual platforms and work packets. Assigned virtual work and/or packets need to be completed and submitted as instructed by grade level Kumu for attendance.
- For Grades 3-6 Hui Lama: Students are at home with adult supervision, receiving instruction
 daily via virtual platforms which may include independent learning times and work packets.
 Assigned virtual work and/or packets need to be completed and submitted as instructed by grade
 level Kumu for attendance.
- For Grades 7-12: Students are at home receiving instruction with a combination of virtual instruction and independent learning times. Assigned virtual work and/or packets need to be completed and submitted as instructed by grade level Kumu for attendance.

Schedule

The bell schedules will change for Quarter 3.

- January 4th Teacher Workday (no students)
- January 5- March 12 Students will begin a Hybrid Learning Model on a rotation schedule (AAVBB)

o Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday 7:45am - 2:00pm

o Wednesdays 7:45am - 1:00pm

• The blended rotational schedule for students coming face to face will be:

Hui Mokihana students will come to school on Mondays and Tuesdays

o Hui Maile Lauli'i students will come to school on Thursdays and Fridays

• Wednesdays will a distance learning/virtual day

• Hui Kōpiko students will come to school up to 4 days/week or daily

Health & Safety

For in-person learning we will continue to practice safety guidelines and protocols:

- physical distancing (i.e., maintaining at least 6 ft distance or 2 arm's length from others)
- washing hands and/or use of hand sanitizers
- Wearing masks upon drop off at campus
- Increased cleaning and sanitizing schedules
- Grade level cohorts
- Daily wellness screening

Lunch & Bus

Lunch service will be provided beginning January 5th, on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday by Epic Eats. Menu choices and lunch payments can be processed through EZ School Pay (ezschoolpay.com). Login information is the same for returning 'ohana, while new 'ohana will need to set up an account. Fees are: Nominal \$.10, Reduced \$.50, Full \$3.00 and Limahana \$5.50.

Bus Service will continue, to north east and south west routes on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Riders will be visually screened upon entrance and must be wearing a mask. Seating will be 2 per seat, with the exception of siblings or keiki in the same household, who may sit together.
