Aloha e ka 'ohana Kawaiikini:

We hope you were able to celebrate Lā Lei with your 'ohana! Kawaiikini, along with all other Hawai'i public schools will continue closure through May 28th. We are sad that our school year has ended abruptly, however share the kuleana to keep our community healthy and safe. Our Kumu and staff will be returning to kula in the next few weeks to assist in gathering haumāna personal belongings from classrooms. Please drive up to Hale Piko and remain in your vehicle. We will be wearing masks and retrieve any materials, and deliver belongings and mea'ai to you. **Haumāna must return their chromebooks, textbooks and any kula issued equipment and/or materials. Items not returned will incur an obligation which will need to be paid at the school office.**

### **Refunds**

All lunch payments received for March 23-31 and April will be reimbursed. All one-way and roundtrip bus payments received for quarter 4 will also be reimbursed. Checks will be issued to the payor in our system and mailed out by May 20th.

**Haumāna Learning:**

All haumāna will continue to be provided with learning and enrichment materials through May 28. Due to this unprecedented situation, 4th quarter grades will be left blank and this period will be used to ensure Continuity of Learning and opportunities to improve the final grade of all students.

Kula Kualua (Papa 7-12): All haumāna are being given the opportunity to improve their final grade by completing both missing and new assignments. You should have received 3rd quarter report cards with the most recent grades. Please contact your Kumu directly for questions on how to improve the final grade.

Kula Ha‘ah‘a (Papa M-6):

Haumāna not meeting proficiency levels will be provided multiple opportunities to demonstrate proficiency through the last day, May 28. Please contact your Kumu for information on improving proficiency.
