Re: Return to school schedule changes and cancellation of events due to COVID-19

Aloha e nā makua:

Kawaiikini will close our ke'ena except for essential functions effective Thursday, March 19. We will close March 30 following the extension of spring break. Limahana return dates will be staggered. Haumāna are anticipated to return to school April 7. Limahana who need to perform duties at a campus or office during this period will be limited to those tasks, and may work remotely.

The HIDOE and Charter School Commission will be meeting internally and with key stakeholders today to finalize logistics. Additional details will be made public at a press conference on Thursday, March 19, 2020, 3 p.m.

Kawaiikini is following preventative measures for large gatherings, therefore the following changes are in effect:

- Kaua'i Charter School Prom is canceled and not rescheduled for another date (April 18)
- Hālāwai Kula: makua quarterly meeting is postponed (April 9)
- WASC Accreditation visit is postponed to Fall 2020 (April 5-8)
